He was an active member of the *Studebaker Driving Club Hamilton Chapter* until 2021. Cliff was an active participant in many SDC activities. He will be sorely missed.

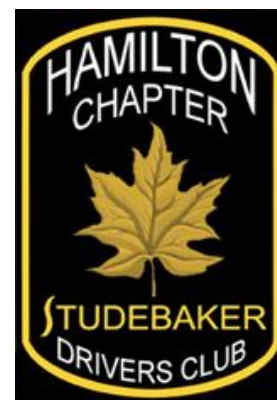
